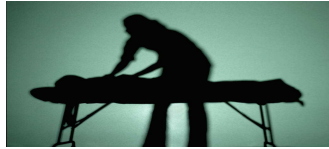


Robin Pyatt Bellamy, one of Canada's premier Paranormal Researchers, talks about how

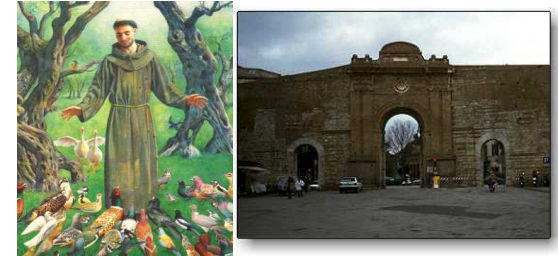
